



## Red Elm (*Ulmus rubra*)

**Region:** North America    **Figure Type:** Plain    **Cut(s):** Quarter

Sapwood is grayish-white to light brown while the heartwood is reddish-brown to dark brown. Can also be more pale. The grain is straight, sometimes interlocked, and has a coarse texture. Common applications: Architectural panels, millwork, cabinetry, furniture and doors.
