



## Oak Chrome (*Quercus petraea*)

**Region:** Europe

**Figure Type:** Plain

To achieve this Chrome look, the wood undergoes an ionization process, which has more control than fuming—however, the individual amount of chemicals in each tree affects its overall shade, so its not as accurate as dyeing to the same color each time. Common applications: Architectural panels, millwork, cabinetry and doors, as well as furniture.
