Position Overview

Lead day-to-day operations of the Wood Veneer Face Department to ensure safe, efficient, and high-quality production. Own staffing, scheduling, quality control, order throughput, and inventory alignment while partnering closely with Sales and the President.

Key Responsibilities

- Production & Throughput

- Plan, grade, and complete production orders on schedule; meet requested quantity, monitor yield %, and grade-out targets (A/B/Sound).
- Ensure all orders for spliced veneer faces or laminated veneer sheets (2-Ply) are delivered on-time and within specification.
- Establish, track, and adjust daily/weekly production goals.
- Review sales orders and align production sequencing to delivery commitments.

- Quality Control

- Own quality of manufacturing and the outgoing product:
- Proper trimming of veneer for Face quality needed.
- Glue line quality (application rate, bond strength, etc.).
- Lamination adhesion (no delamination, passing boil tests).
- Conduct grade-out reviews; drive corrective actions when targets are missed.
- Ensure production paperwork is accurate and precise.

- People Leadership

- Keep department properly staffed and trained; build schedules, assign work, and cross-train to reduce bottlenecks.
- Set clear expectations, coach for performance. Initiate corrective disciplinary actions when needed (tardiness, absenteeism, policy violations, performance).
- Conduct performance and pay reviews in partnership with the President.

- Materials & Inventory

- Forecast raw veneer needs from upcoming customer POs; review inventory and notify the warehouse when veneer is required.
- Maintain finished-goods inventory accuracy; track fine-tuned grades by crate to support order fulfillment.

- Equipment & Uptime

- Keep machines operational: coordinate PM, repairs, and a proactive spare-parts program.
- Immediately notify the President of unplanned downtime impacting schedule.

- Communication & Reporting

 Provide timely updates to the President when: new veneer is needed, quality issues arise, shipments risk delay, inventory drifts out of balance, machines go down, production is delayed, shipments are delayed, or personnel changes occur.
